First Irish Winner of the Oslo Business for Peace Award



At a ceremony in Oslo on the 16th May 2018, the Business for Peace Foundation declared its 2018 Honourees. Mr Martin Naughton, Glen Dimplex, was the first ever Irish Honouree of the Foundation following his nomination by South Dublin Chamber in conjunction with Chambers Ireland and the Northern Ireland Chamber of Commerce and Industry. Peter Byrne, Chief Executive of South Dublin Chamber said: "Mr Naughton is a true business pioneer. From a modest start in Newry, he has created a global business which is now playing a significant role in the development of low-carbon, sustainable heating systems. His successful work in the spheres of education and the development of North-South and Irish-US relationships are a testament to his outstanding public-mindedness."

Background to Foundation and Honourees:

The Business for Peace Foundation is an NGO based in Oslo which was created in 2007. Its mission is to support, inspire, and recognize the global business leaders who are positively changing the face of business.

The Oslo Business for Peace Honourees commenced in 2009. Mr Naughton is the first Irish Honouree. Previous honourees include Elon Musk, Emily Cummins, Sir Richard Branson, Durreen Shahnaz, Jeffrey Immelt and Ratan Tata.

The selection of Honourees is undertaken by an independent Award Committee comprising 5 Nobel laureates in Peace and Economics who are all outstanding role models within their respective fields, with a passion for improving society driving their endeavours. The 2018 panel comprised Ms Ouided Bouchamaoui, Dr. Shirin Ebadi, Professor Finn Kydland, Ms Leymah Gbowee, and Professor Eric Maskin.

A New University for a Changing World



The alliance of Dublin Institute of Technology, Institute of Technology Blanchardstown and Institute of Technology Tallaght is set to become the first Technological University (TU Dublin) in Ireland, as revealed by An Taoiseach Leo Varadkar TD. The University will be located on three campuses at Grangegorman, Blanchardstown and Tallaght creating an inclusive and open learning experience offering pathways to graduation from apprenticeship to PhD level to a diverse range of students.

As part of Technological University Dublin, the Tallaght campus will continue to expand its academic programmes and research activity, as well as community and enterprise supports to the South Dublin County Region. Two new building projects are currently in progress on the 41 acre campus with planned completion dates in 2021. The first is a 5,200 m2 multi-disciplinary building as part of the Government's PPP programme, combining teaching space, hospitality and culinary arts as well as engineering and apprenticeship activities. The second building is a Sports Science, Health and Recreation building including outdoor sporting facilities.

Rule 4	Data shall at all times be kept safe and secure	Integrity & Confidentiality
Rule 5	Data shall at all times be accurate and kept up to date	Accuracy
Rule 6	Data shall be kept adequate, accurate and not excessive	Data Minimisation
Rule 7	Data shall not be kept for longer than is necessary and disposed of when no longer necessary	Storage Limitation
Rule 8	Data subjects are entitled to rights under the legislation	Transparency & Openness
